The map shows the extended network of a Pacific Northwest News Ecology through a technique called co-link analysis, whereby all URLs of attendees of 'Re-imagining News & Community in the Pacific Northwest' are crawled, outlinks are captured and the URLs on the map received at least two links from the attendee seeds.

The mapping technique is built into the Issuecrawler by the Govcom.org Foundation, Amsterdam, and was first employed for an event at the Ruckus Techtools Action Camp, June 2002. Large-scale visualization by ReseauLu, Aguidel, Paris
