
Pacific Northwest News Ecology - Links between Websites

Journalism That Matters. Re-imagining News & Community in the Pacific Northwest, 2010



The map shows the interlinkings between URLs of the attendees of the Pacific Northwest News Ecology conference. The placement as well as the size of nodes are significant. Size of node is based on quantities of links given and received, and placement is determined by strength of ties, i.e., of all ties, which ties bring nodes closest together (according to quantity), in a standard network analytical sense. Isolates giving no links and receiving no links from network are not shown.
